







Once you have logged into Hera_Pro, click on "Auctions" within the Sourcing section to view the list of current Auctions you are invited to participate in




Display Auction






If the option is enabled by the Buyer, an Area is available to create messages, view received messages, drafts, and those sent directly to Hera




At this point, click on "Auction Monitor" in the upper right corner to enter the area and place your bid




Entering a Bid



In this case, you are no longer in first position because another vendor has offered a better price before the deadline of the Auction




Auction Deadline




Winning bid


After the Buyer has selected the auction winner, if your bid was the selected one, a trophy symbol will be displayed in the Status column and you will receive an award confirmation email





Presence of the new "Lots List" Tab within the "Auction Details" Page to view all details of individual lots configured by the Buyer




Display of Lots within the Auction Monitor




Click on the arrow to open the individual Lot and enter your bid
