ExtraMOT's green segment continues to grow with Hera bond

The Hera S.p.A. stock listed on Borsa Italiana's ExtraMOT market has been included in the segment dedicated to green and/or social bonds, created to offer institutional and retail investors a way to identify those instruments whose return is destined to finance projects with a specific environmental and/or social benefit or impact.

In particular, in 2014 the multi-utility offered a ten-year bond issue destined to finance or refinance projects involving sustainability in 4 areas: contrasting climate change, reducing emissions, water purification quality and waste management. For each line of action, Hera has identified a series of specific investments on which to activate a monitoring and reporting process to ensure that the market is correctly and transparently informed of the use made of the funds collected for the projects. The issue amounts to 500 million overall, with maturity at ten years, a coupon of 2.375% and return coming to 2.436%.

With the Hera bond, the green securities listed on the Italian Stock Exchange bond markets have been enriched by a further significant corporate issue at European level.
