The Hera Group is a "champion" in energy efficiency

The multi-utility received the FIRE - Energy Manager 2019 award, one of the most coveted awards in the sector at national level. The prize was awarded based on the activities carried out internally within the company to promote the rational use of energy

Energy efficiency record holders; the Hera Group has been recognized among the Italian companies most capable of promoting the rational use of energy. This was decided by the highest national body in the sector: the FIRE (Italian Federation for the Rational Use of Energy), which for the past three years has established the FIRE - Energy Manager Award. The Hera Group has now participated for the first time and immediately took the podium, thus obtaining an important recognition, on an equal footing with two other Italian companies, active in the civil and tertiary sectors.

The award ceremony took place yesterday, in Milan, in the context of Enermanagement XII, a conference dedicated to energy management, resource management and the core business, at the end of a round table in which Hera Group experts also participated.

The award assigned to the Hera Group is of great value, as it recognizes the attention and commitment that the company has always placed in the efficient use of energy in all its activities, starting with the overall goal of reducing its own energy consumption of 5% by 2020, with a saving of over 8 million euro compared to 2013 energy expenditure.

The results are made possible by integrated efficiency programs, carried out continuously by the Hera Group in its plants and in its offices. Among the numerous actions implemented, the multi-utility implemented an ISO 50001 certified Energy Management System throughout the entire organization with the aim of pursuing continuous improvement of its energy performance. The unified framework of the ISO 50001 Management System has made the actions carried out within the Group more effective, directing choices and investments to the achievement of corporate energy saving objectives. The result is coherent and reinforced action, aimed at continuous improvement and rational use of resources.

In addition, the multi-utility prepares periodic energy diagnoses relating to its activities, even if not required by regulatory obligations, and has activated an energy monitoring system for the most significant consumption centers.

The numerous efficiency improvement initiatives carried out by the various corporate structures in recent years have contributed to awarding the prize, such as the revamping of cogeneration plants, participation in the aggregate dispatching market, the provision of building automation systems and efficient lighting. in the offices.
